What to Expect

For your first visit we will ask you to fill out a short form with questions (Name, address, date of birth, ect.) that help us serve you better. We will also ask you to fill out an Emergency Food Assistance Form (TEFAP).

We don't need proof of residence or income!

Just bring yourself and a mask!

A staff member will be available to answer any questions you have about our paperwork.

Anyone that needs food is welcome to visit our pantry.

You do not need to meet an income guideline.

Our Food Pantry is a drive-through!

When you enter our parking lot please pull up to the Food Pantry sign and stay in your vehicle.

Our volunteers will need to pack groceries into the trunk of your car, so please create space for them. If you are unable to use the trunk you will have to pull over and load your own groceries.

Our volunteers are NOT allowed to pack groceries into the back seat of your car!

Walk-Ups Are Welcome

If you are walking please walk up, with a mask on, to the first yellow line on the ground by the front doors and wait for our volunteers to assist you.

If you do not see anyone please ring the doorbell on your right.

Our Services

We rely heavily on donated food, this means we may not have all products available!

Every visit we provide:

- **A box of dry goods** such as breakfast items, canned items, personal care items, etc.
- **Frozen Meat** should remain frozen until ready for use. Thaw and cook on the same day.
- **Dairy** which often includes milk and yogurt.
- **Eggs**
- An assortment of **Fresh Produce**. Please wash all produce before using.
- **Bread**
- **Diapers** size 1-6 and adult depending on availability.
- **Baby Food and Formula** when available
- **Tampons and Pads** when available

If you are over 60 years old please ask about our Senior Box Program.
